The Top 50 Shag Songs of 2006

The Association of Beach and Shag Club DeeJays has once again compiled its list of the Top 50 Shag Songs of the previous twelve months. This list for 2006 once again had a runaway in the top spot as The Mighty Mike Schermer Band took with first place with their mega shag hit, "My Big Sister's Radio." It beat the number two song of the year by over 300 points, although Rick Strickland and "Something Smooth" dropped only from first place to second place over the last twelve months. Congratulations to both artists and to all of the artists and groups that made the list for 2006.

This list was compiled with the assistance of 32 members of the Association of Beach & Shag Club DeeJays and carries on the tradition established by the late Charlie Byrd (Carawan) of compiling an annual listing of the top shag songs of the previous year from votes cast by mobile DeeJays playing in the shag community. This was the largest group of our members to participate to date and we thank them. As always, since his death, this list is dedicated to the memory of Charlie and the Charlie Byrd Beach Blast.

Please support the DeeJays whose names you will find on the back of this brochure, they are the ones who took the time to think back over the past year and compile a list of their top fifty shag songs based on requests and simply observing the dance floor when they played and seeing what filled the floor over the course of the year.

This listing, as has been done in the past, is not a listing of the best new shag songs of the year, but also includes a number of old standards that still work their magic on the dancers across the southeast when they are played. The intent

is to list the fifty best shag songs, not the best of the newest shag songs of the year.

Here are a few interesting tidbits gleaned from an examination of the final list:

- The contributing DeeJays submitted a total of 522 different songs this year, confirming that there are many regional favorites that may not have received enough votes to make the "Top 50" but are still strong in their areas.
- The oldest song, once again for 2006, was "I Used To Cry Mercy Mercy" by the Lamplighters, released in 1954. Other "old" favorites that continue to make the annual list include: "Lady Soul" by the Temptations; "How Do You Stop" by James Brown; and "Come Get To This" by Marvin Gaye.
- 24 of the 50 songs on this year's list are repeats from last year, an indication of the longevity that really good songs have in our shag clubs

We hope you enjoy reviewing this list and that you see many of your favorites on it. Thanks again to the 32 DeeJays who took the time to contribute their own personal Top 50 for 2006.
